ANCIENT ART

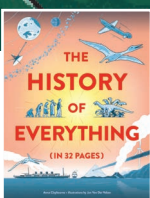
The *First Humans* spread looks at some ancient artworks, including the amazing cave paintings at Lascaux in France.

- Research using books or the Internet to find some photos of the Lascaux cave art
- Then try creating your own, using red, orange and black pencils, chalks or pastels
- You could draw animals you see around you today, like your pets, birds or insects – or try drawing scenes from your daily life
- Imagine people 17,000 years into the future find your drawings – what will they reveal about what life is like today?

ELECTRIC WORLD

Electricity has always existed in the form of lightning, but it was only around 250 years ago that we learned to control it and started using electric lighting, machines and gadgets, like the inventions you can see on the Technology spread.

- Keep a notebook with you for a day and make a list of all the electrical items you use or benefit from – alarm clock, tablet, TV, toaster, fridge, dishwasher, watch, lightbulbs, projector, street lighting, electric toothbrush – and so on
- Now imagine what life would be like without anything electrical at all – how would you do all the things in your day if you didn't have electricity?

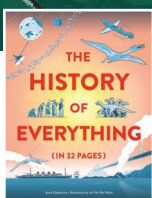
